The present issue is dedicated to Academician VLADIMÍR HAJKO on the festive occasion of the 70th anniversary of his birthday which he celebrates on 3rd October 1990. His important participation in the development of the physical research in Slovakia and especially in its eastern part is well known.

Academician Hajko deserved well of the development of the magnetism in Slovakia. He founded this research field in Košice and his broad scientific and organizational activities contributed much to high reputation of this field of research both in this country and abroad and to founding an acknowledged school in magnetism at Košice. He started to organize regular conferences on magnetism; the contributions presented at the 8th Conference on Magnetism are published just in this issue.

His broad organizational and pedagogical activities contributing to progress in science and education in Slovakia should be acknowledged too. He contributed significantly to the development of the Institute of Experimental Physics of the Slovak Academy of Sciences in Košice and to founding and building the Faculty of Sciences of the P. J. Šafárik University in Košice where he worked for a quite long time. Connected with his name is also a series of successful books e. g. Physics in Examples, Physics in Experiments, Foundations of Physics etc.

Academician Hajko is an outstanding scientific and pedagogical personality. He is member of both Czechoslovak and Slovak Academies of Sciences, and member of Academies in the Soviet Union and in GDR.
